Questions Т  $\mathbf{F}$ 1. HIV vascular disease manifests as aneurysmal and occlusive disease. 2. HAART may cause coronary artery disease. 3. HIV positive patients are not hypercoagulable. 4. Deaths due to anaesthesia may be as low as 0, 5-0, 8 per 100,000. 5. An intraoperative death has no psychological impact on the anaesthetist. 6. Re-expansion pulmonary oedema (REPE) never occurs after drainage of a pneumothorax. 7 The mortality of re-expansion pulmonary oedema is high. 8. Various mechanisms are proposed in the development of REPE including damage by free radicals. 9. All patients that are admitted to the PACU require oxygen administration. 10 Critical Incident Stress Debriefing should be available to anaesthetists after being involved in an intraoperative death. 11. The current study suggests that the typical South African seeking treatment for chronic pain tends to be female, forty years of age or older and has completed 12 years or less of formal education. 12. The levels of pain severity, affective distress and negative responses from significant others reported by patients in the current study are in line with the data reported for European and North American chronic pain populations. 13. The current study tends to suggest that chronic pain patients run a higher risk of becoming dependant upon, or addicted to medications/substances. 14. The minority of chronic pain suffers report a general preoccupation with various aspects of their physical health. 15. Most chronic pain patients in the current study presented with significantly elevated levels of depression and anxiety. Hallermann-Streiff syndrome has autosomal dominant inheritance 16. 17. About 5% of children with Hallermann-Streiff syndrome have an underlying cardiac defect. 18. Children with Hallermann-Streiff syndrome may be difficult to intubate in view of their microstomia and micrognathia. 19. 50% of children with Hallermann-Streiff syndrome are intelectually handicapped. 20. Hallermann and Streiff were buddies and described the syndrome together.
